Pixius Communications completes the addition of the Asbury and Carthage, MO service areas

Kansas-based broadband provider offers new service

WICHITA, KS – High Speed Internet service from Pixius Communications, LLC (Pixius) is now available in Asbury, Brooklyn Heights, Carl Junction, Carterville, Carthage, Gulfton, Knights, Maxville, Pleasant Valley, Scotland and Webb City, MO with improved service in Medoc, Neck City and Preston, MO. Now, consumers and businesses in these areas have a new choice to replace slow dial-up services and an alternative to cable, satellite, 3G cellular and DSL services.

The introduction of this service is a portion of Pixius' plan to bring high speed broadband data service to unserved and underserved areas in Kansas and Missouri. "Pixius serves the most unserved areas in the region," says Pixius Chief Executive Officer Jay Maxwell. "But not for Pixius, many of our service areas would never have access to quality, affordable high-speed Internet service."

For about the same price as cable or DSL, Pixius' wireless broadband solution — called eXtendsm — provides fast and reliable Internet access. Data download

rates for the wireless broadband service range from 768 Kbps to more than 1.5 Mbps, depending on the service option and other factors. Upload rates range from 384 Kbps to more than 1.5 Mbps. These speeds are minimums as opposed to often advertised 'up to' rates which are seldom achieved. The service can be tailored to meet specific business needs.

Commenting on the service quality and the economics of the expansion, Maxwell said, "The service deployed represents the core competencies of the company. Pixius provides quality infrastructure and affordable service. In the near future, we plan to leverage these competencies and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) to further expand coverage in the region."

The eXtendsm wireless broadband is marketed locally by Pixius Communications.

Pixius' wireless broadband was launched in Wichita, KS in late 2002 and now provides service to more than 5600 customers in Kansas and Missouri. The service is delivered via a network of more than 50 communications towers.

The service works with all types of internet products and tools, such as Virtual Private Networks (VPN), Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) and requires no special software. Pixius trained technicians can typically install the system within a week of order placement.
